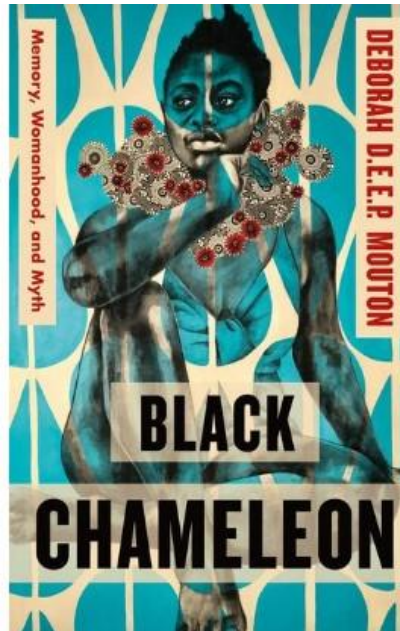

She is the author of the 2019 poetry collection *Newsworthy* and has been a contributing writer for *Glamour* and *Texas Monthly*, among other outlets. As a playwright and a librettist, she has penned multiple stage works including *Marian's Song* (2020) with Houston Grand Opera & *The Forest of Secrets* (2022). Her recent memoir *Black Chameleon* (2023) examines womanhood by way of mythology. Deborah DEEP Mouton will read from this text, present poetry, and engage in conversation about her work.
